**Re: GBHS Wellness & Treatment Centre - Community Engagement & Planning Update**

Further to our communication a few weeks ago, we are writing to you to share updates on our planning and community engagement opportunities. Our goal is to share information and respond to questions as we launch into the structural and operational planning phase of the Wellness & Treatment Centre project. It is expected the work on this project will take between 9-12 months to complete.

We have received some valuable feedback to date from residents and will be working with our contractors, municipal leaders and others to incorporate what we can into our planning. Some of the ideas to date that are being explored include building a fence along property lines, adding shrubs or trees, re-opening the entrance/exit on 6<sup>th</sup> Street East and possibly limiting entrance points on 6<sup>th</sup> St. A East. As these ideas and new ones are identified, we will continue to explore and share status.

Attached to this letter is a graphic identifying where to find the most current information and updates. As part of this Community Engagement Framework, we have organized multiple phases of engagement opportunities. An information flyer detailing these opportunities is enclosed.
